BEFORE

IF YOU ARE DOING A LOCK CHANGE, YOU CAN USUALLY USE THE AFTER PHOTO OF THE LOCK CHANGE FOR THE BEFORE PHOTO FOR THE LOCKBOX. SOME CLIENTS MIGHT NEED YOU TO TAKE 2 PHOTOS.

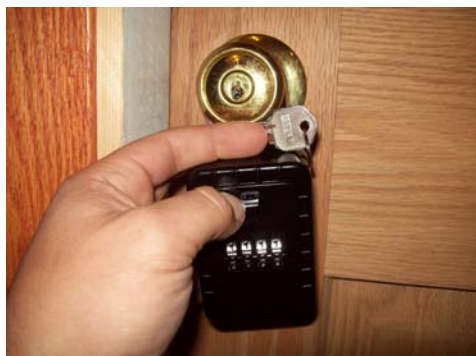
I FEEL THIS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT PICTURE. YOU CAN READ THE LOCKBOX IS SET TO NCN, THE KEYS ARE VISIBLE AND SHOW THE 35241 CODE, AND THE LEVER ON THE COVER IS DEPRESSED. IT WOULD BE HARD TO ARGUE AGAINST THIS PICTURE IF A REALTOR OR INSPECTOR SAYS YOU DIDN'T INSTALL THE LOCKBOX TO THE CORRECT CODE OR LEAVE THE CORRECT KEYS.
